The alluvial terraces of the river Perquilauquén, the clonal selection of Cabernet and Merlot, the Italian style of the owner, the dry climate of the Maule Valley have contributed to obtain such an elegant wine rarely reached by Chilean wines. But it is not only that: Erasmo is also the leader of a group of excellent red wines from the Valley which are giving prestige to this area known, until now, more for the quantity produced than for its quality. Erasmo is its best example.



The best blend of this year was conceived by this little wine cellar of the Maule Valley. Behind this project there is the owner of the famous Tuscan estate "Col d'Orcia": Count Francesco Marone Cinzano who, in 2004, has made a wine uncommon to find in this side of the world. Rarely for example you can taste such elegance, delicacy, fruity freshness: its great complexity is disguised as fruity simplicity, of red crisp fruits and of spices. An excellent wine.
