Vina la Reserva de Caliboro Erasmus 2001, Maule Valley, Chile (\$26)

A stunning wine from the Count Francesco Marone Cinzano's relatively new Chilean winery. Best known as the owner of top Brunello house Col D'Orcia (actually, he is best-known because of his family name), Cinzano has taken Chilean wine to new heights at an affordable price. Deep and rich in colour, the palate is caressed by the beautiful texture and ripe flavours of cherries, blackberries, liquorice and spice. Elegant and concentrated with firm, yet supple tannins. A nice touch of acidity should allow this glorious wine to last for at least a decade. Perhaps Chile's best wine for the dollar.
